# AMONG US BEANIE

Basic: Half Double Crochet beanie



#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

mr = magic ring.

cs = chain stitch.

sl st = slip stitch

sts = stitch.

dec = decrease.

inc = increase.

rep. = repeat

hdc = half double crochet

#### MATERIALS:

Crochet needle - 4.5 mm

Yarn - scheepjes color crafter or any DK yarn (UK)/Light Worsted yarn (US)

Gugde: 14 sts pr. 10 cm

green pipe cleaner

Stitch marker

Needle for weaving in ends and sewing together

A half double crochet beanie is nothing new, there are thousands of patterns on the internet for these kinds of beanies, some are free others are paid versions. I am not inventing something new here nor do I try. This pattern is free to use in any way, shape or form you choose but please do not use my photos without permission and I would appreciate it if you would refer to my website if you chose to use this pattern. ### **Basic Beanie Pattern Instructions**

The sizes I provide here are because I am assuming that a child under the age of 6 is not playing the game, Among us. If there is a need for a smaller/bigger size do contact me and I will try to help with that or use any free pattern beanie you can find on the internet that offers the size you need.

#### 6 to 8 years

Size: 45.5-48.5 cm/18-19" head circumference

Round 1) Start with the MR, 10 hdc into the MR, sl st [10]

Round 2) inc hdc in each stitch [20]

Round 3) \*inc, 1 hdc\* rep round [30]

Round 4) \*inc, 2 hdc\* rep round [40]

Round 5) \*inc, 3 hdc\* rep round [50]

Round 6) \*inc, 4 hdc\* rep round [60]

Round 7) 20 hdc, \*inc, 5 hdc\* rep 3 times, inc, 1 hdc in the remaining sts [64]

Round 8-30) 1 hdc in each sts in the round (do less or more rounds, depending on how long you want the beanie to be) [64]

Finish off with an invisible join and weave in ends.

#### 9 to 11 years

Size: 49-51 cm/19.5-20" head circumference

Round 1) Start with the MR, 10 hdc into the MR, sl st [10]

Round 2) inc hdc in each stitch [20]

Round 3) \*inc, 1 hdc\* rep round [30]

Round 4) \*inc, 2 hdc\* rep round [40]

Round 5) \*inc, 3 hdc\* rep round [50]

Round 6) \*inc, 4 hdc\* rep round [60]

Round 7) 8 hdc, \*inc, 5 hdc\* rep 7 times, inc, 1 hdc in the remaining sts [68]

Round 8-30) 1 hdc in each sts in the round (do less or more rounds, depending on how long you want the beanie to be) [68]

Finish off with an invisible join and weave in ends.

#### Teen/adult small

Round 1) Start with the MR, 10 hdc into the MR, sl st [10]

Round 2) inc hdc in each stitch [20]

Round 3) \*inc, 1 hdc\* rep round [30]

Round 4) \*inc, 2 hdc\* rep round [40]

Round 5) \*inc, 3 hdc\* rep round [50]

Round 6) \*inc. 4 hdc\* rep round [60]

Round 7) \*inc, 5 hdc\* rep round [70]

Round 8-30) 1 hdc in each sts in the round (do less or more rounds, depending on how long you want the beanie to be) [70]

Finish off with an invisible join and weave in ends.

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## Helmet/Glass (color, white or light blue): (still working in hdc)

Round 1) chain 19, turn, 1 triple inc; 16 hdc; continue to the other side of the chain and crochet 1 triple inc, 16 hdc. [38]

Round 2) 3 inc, 16 hdc, 3 inc, 16 hdc [44]

Round 3) 6 inc, 16 hdc, 6 inc, 17 hdc [56]

Round 3) 12 inc, 16 hdc, 12 inc, 16 hdc [80]

Change color to black

Round 4) 1 hdc in each sts round [80]

Finish off with an invisible join and weave in ends.

#### Leaf (make2):

- 1.) chain 20, turn, sl st in the 2 chain from the hook, 4 sl st, 3 sc, 2 hdc, 4 dc, 2 hdc, 2 sc, trible inc, continue to the other side of the chain, 2 sc, 2 hdc, 4 dc, 2 hdc, 3 sc, 5 sl st [39]
- 2.) Turn, chain 1, 5 sl st in back loop only, then 14 sc, chain 1, 1 sc in next sts, chain 1, 1 sc in same sts, chain 1, hen 14 sc, 5 sl st in back loop only. Finish off with an invisible join and weave in ends [41]
- 3.) Change color to black and sc around both leafs and stem. Finish off with an invisible join and leave long black ends for later [41]

Use green pipe cleaner to stabilize the leaves and use it to hold it up from the top of the hat.

Put the leaves together as you prefer and sew them together with the ends.

The end of the pipe cleaner can be put into the MR on top of the hat and twisted up through the stitches and wrapped around the bottom of the leaves, twist the black left over yarn around the pipe cleaner to hide it and close off the end.





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
